Prenatal Care Grant:

Per Amended Substitute **House Bill 11**, signed by Governor DeWine on June 19th, ODH was awarded \$5M to develop and implement a group prenatal care grant in Stat Fiscal Year '21. The Group Prenatal Care Initiatives Grant (PC21) has been reposted with <u>expanded eligibility</u> for the planning scope of work.

Ohio HB 606 signed by Governor DeWine to expand immunity for healthcare workers

Governor DeWine recently signed HB 606 which will "make temporary changes related to qualified civil immunity for health care and emergency services provided during a government-declared disaster or emergency and for exposure to or transmission or contraction of certain coronaviruses".
